A Word to Worshippers

Each summer many from our congregation serve on short-term mission trips. When the trips are all concluded we devote a large part of a Sunday morning to viewing and hearing the results of their missions. Today our teams to Africa, New Orleans, and Mexico serve as a model for our study passage from Romans. They exhibit "Gospel qualities" which led them to sacrifice time and money to work hard for God and his people in remote places. As we worship, a number of our youth (most of whom were members of these mission trips) will serve us in music leadership.
